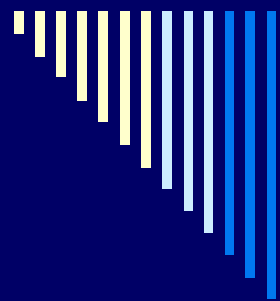


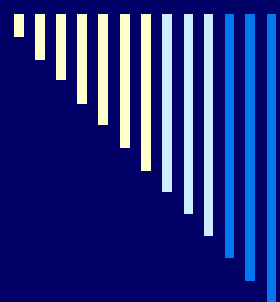

- Use web for sharing of documents

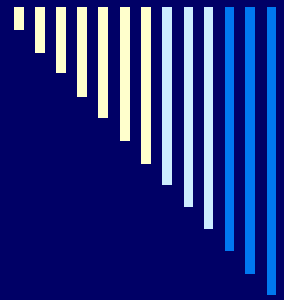

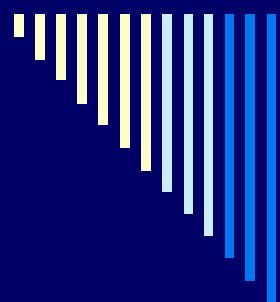
APC Practices (cont)

APC New Program Review Criteria

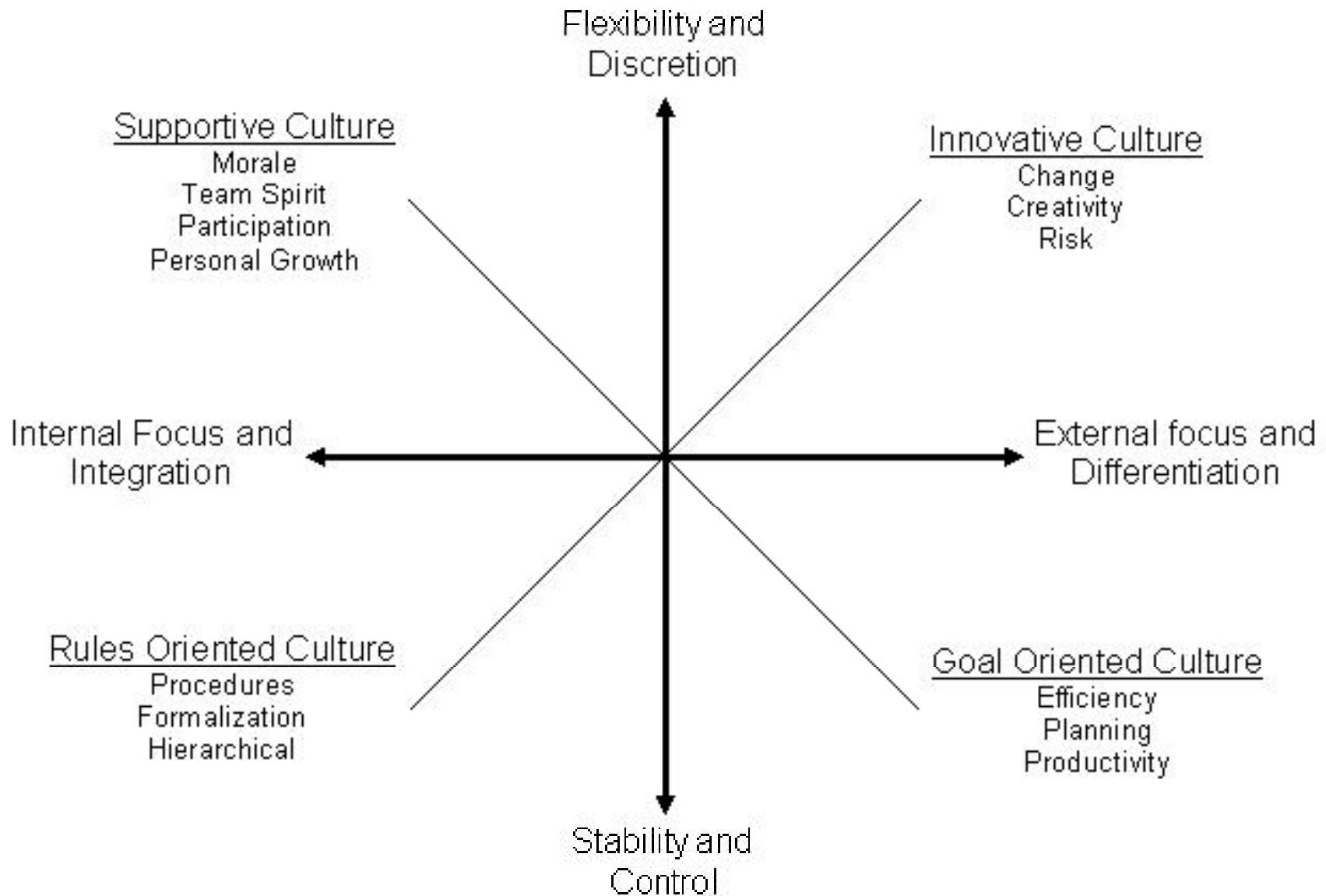
- Criteria for evaluation

 - Resources
 - Impact – Internal and external
 - Cost effectiveness
 - Alternative programs

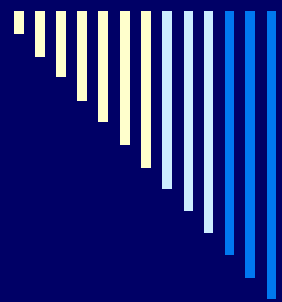


Program Review

- Have accepted all self studies to date

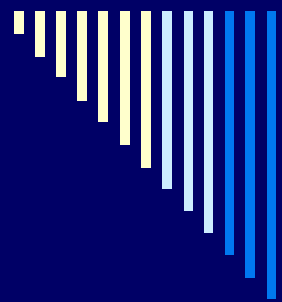
Figure 5: Organizational Culture





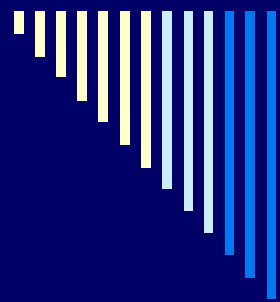
Recent Accomplishments

- Developed new program review procedure
 - Focus on academic programs
 - Focus on learning
 - Future-oriented
 - Continuous improvement
 - Integration academic reporting
 - External review

Stipulations on Affiliation:

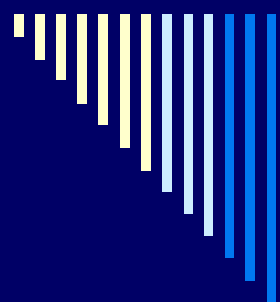
Doctoral degree programs are limited to the main campus in MP, MI expect for Doc Aud, Doc Health Admin and Doc Ed Leadership which are also available through distance delivery. International offering are limited to degree programs in Canada and Mexico (UAG & UVM partners)

New degree sites:

No prior commission approval required for additional CEL degree programs in United States and Canada.

Distance Education:

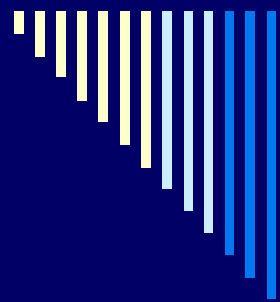
Prior approval required for programs other than Doc Aud, DHA, MSA, BSA

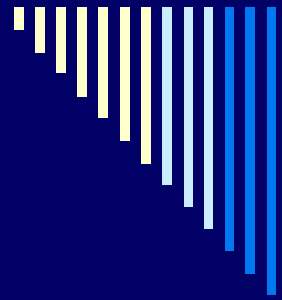
