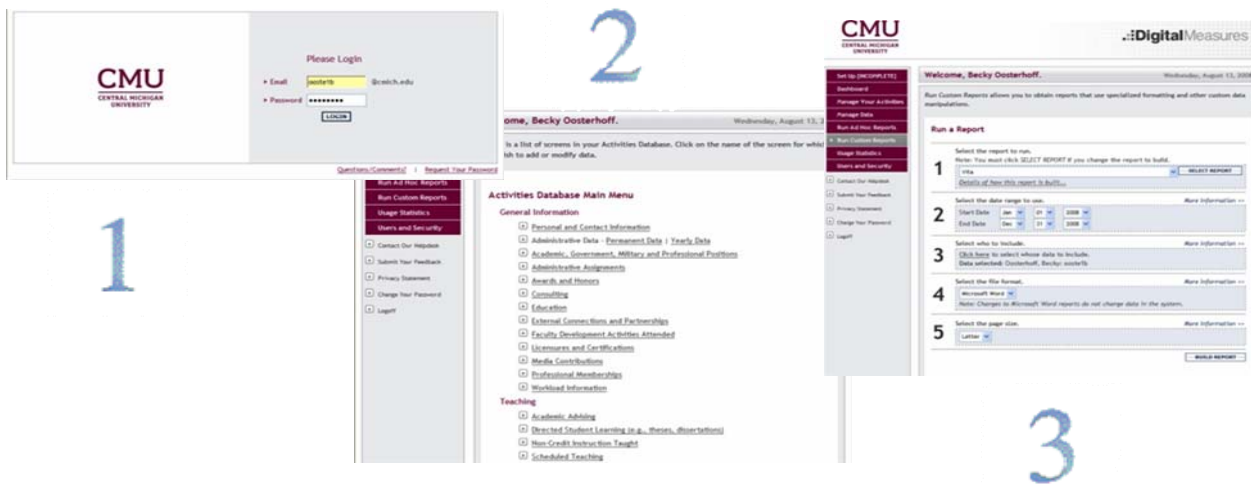


OFIS at CMU



The CMU Online Faculty Information System (OFIS) translates your CV information into reports useful for many purposes including: internal and external grant applications, annual reports that you submit to your college dean, and vitae in a variety of formats. Once your CV is entered into the system, the procedure for creating reports is simple: log on, enter your data, select the report you need from a dropdown menu, then save and/or print it. You will

quickly discover the value of a system that requires your CV data to be entered only one time to meet a multitude of needs. The images below simulate the sequence in which data is entered into the web interface of OFIS.



The first screen welcomes you to enter your scholarly accomplishments into a selection of categories which record teaching, research and service. Once all data are entered (either by you or by trained Academic Affairs student employees), you may select from a variety of reports - created within seconds.

Let our data-entry specialists get you started. Send your vita to ofis@cmich.edu no later than *February 15, 2009*. We will follow-up with you via email encouraging you to review your basic CV report for accuracy. Then it is up to you to keep your information up-to-date.
